

1. To approve a child care leave for Christine Aquilino without pay from May 5, 2010 through June 30, 2010 and FMLA from March 19, 2010 for up to twelve weeks.
2. To approve a child care leave for Rosa Amendola without pay from May 19, 2010 through June 30, 2010 and FMLA from April 7, 2010 for up to twelve weeks.
3. To appoint Angela Gorniak to a temporary appointment effective January 19, 2010 through June 30, 2010 as a Senior Office Assistant at the PVCSD Special Education office on an hourly basis not to exceed .3 FTE at Step 9 of the CSEA salary schedule.

7. To appoint Robert Baker to a temporary appointment as a substitute academic eligibility instructor at the Putnam Valley High School effective January 25, 2010, through June 30, 2010 at the curriculum rate of \$43 per hour.
8. To amend the previously approved child care leave without pay for Alissa Aurigemma to March 5, 2010 through March 19, 2010 and FMLA from January 8, 2010 for up to twelve weeks.
9. To approve the revisions and additions to the substitute/tutor list as attached to this document.
10. To approve Jeannine Lewis as the Special Education Department Coordinator effective January 25, 2010 through the end of the 2009-10 school year (as per the attached memorandum) at the prorated stipend for the Department Coordinator position.
11. To approve that the Superintendent and Board President are authorized to sign an Agreement (as per the attached document) extending the probationary term of Brenda Singer, a 7-12 Foreign Languages tenure area probationary employee, for a twelve month period, through July 31, 2011, as recommended by the Superintendent.
