Each year the funds raised by the PVEF are used for educationally sound programs and projects that cannot be funded by the district budget. Each spring, school administrators, teachers, and parents, or students with the support of their building administrator, are encouraged to submit grant applications. The Foundation's Grant Committee reviews these applications and determines how best to allocate funds based upon each applications overall value to the district.

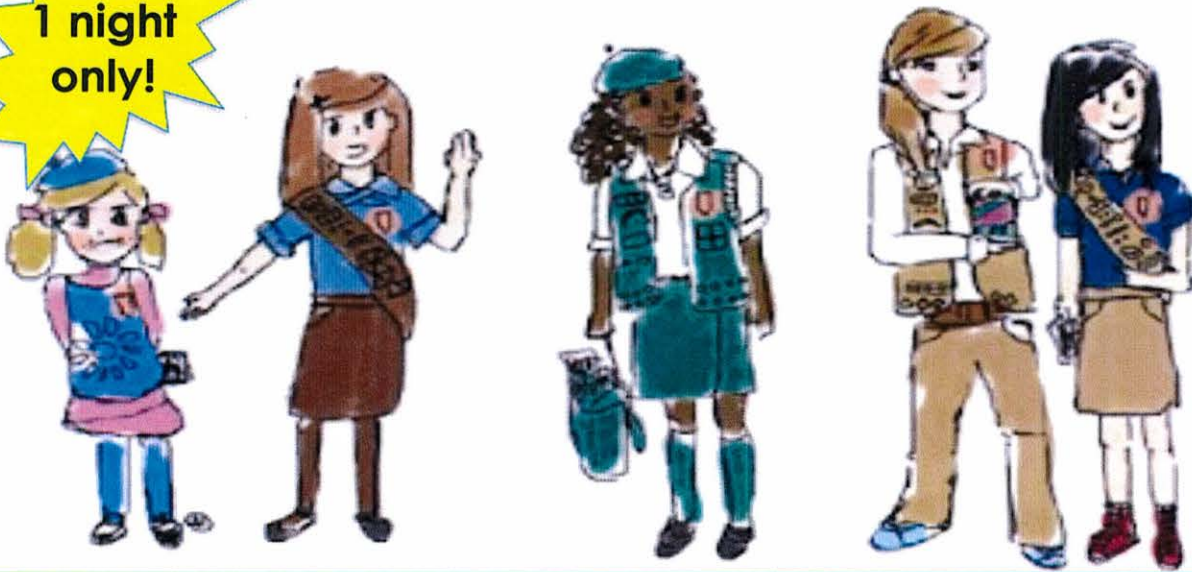

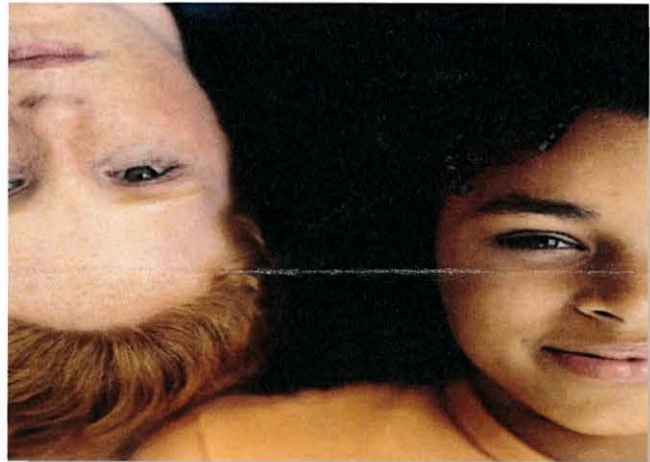
