

This is a two-hour activity where human beings of all ages can choose from a variety of self-guided tutorials, for kindergarteners and up.


Tutorials work on any modern browser, tablet, or smartphone, and some without electronics at all!

Focused on building an interest in science and engineering, Lego Engineering Academy is a hands-on program designed to stimulate your child's creativity. Critical thinking, collaboration, problem solving skills and descriptive language will also be developed as your child constructs models with Lego components.

Classes will be divided into 4 segments.
Children will start exploring with a "free build" time before they learn a new technique or strategy. They will then be presented with a "partner challenge", where they will be asked to collaborate with their peers to solve a specific problem. The class will end by encouraging students to reflect on observations, investigations and problem solving strategies used throughout the class.
