## January 2018 Midterms: <u>General Information</u>

- Midterms will take place for three consecutive days: Tuesday 1/23, Wednesday 1/24, & Thursday 1/25. Each day will be split into three testing sessions: Session 1 (7:30 - 9:15), Session 2 (9:45 - 11:30), Session 3 (12:00 - 1:45).
- Only students scheduled to take exams will be coming into school on midterm days. There will be no regularly-scheduled classes.
- If a student has a test scheduled for Session 1 (7:30) and Session 3 (12:00), they are to remain in the building in between tests. The cafeteria, lounge, and other common areas will be open.
- Students whose first test of the day is Session 2 (9:45) have the following options in getting to school: 1. Take the normal high school bus in (arrival 7:00 AM) 2. Take the middle school bus in (arrival 7:45) 3. Get a ride in from a parent/older sibling.
- For students interested in heading home after the first testing session, there will be a bus dismissal at 9:30 AM each midterm day. In addition, there will be a bus pick-up occurring between 11:00 AM 11:45 AM (check the Midterm bus schedule on the school website for your exact pick-up time) to get students to school for testing Session #3.
- Nearly all 9th, 10th, and 11th graders will be taking midterms in their core subjects. 12th graders taking AP/College-level classes will also be taking midterms
- For the three midterm days, Juniors will be allowed to drive and park on campus. There will be no "assigned spots" during midterms; Seniors and Juniors will both park in the student parking areas.
- A "conflict session" has been set aside on the final day for students who are scheduled to take 2 midterms at the same time
