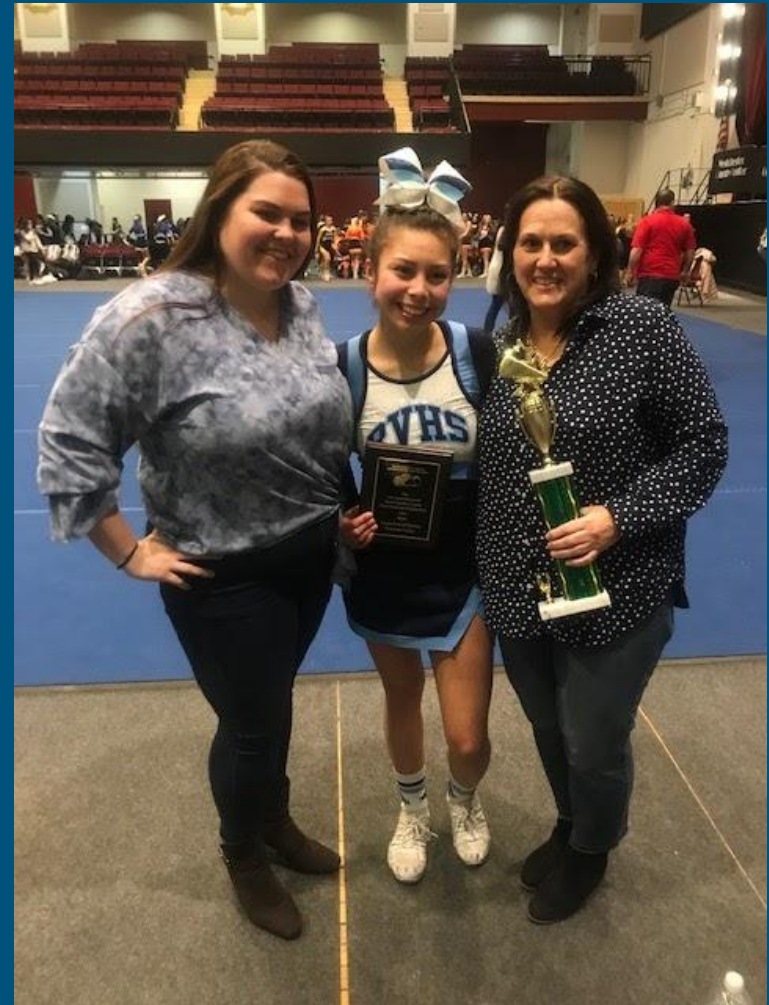
So many successful PV events: Powder Puff, Tiger Tournament, Harlem Wizards, Color Wars and countless others.
