As you know, all school year the children are working hard to improve their reading skills and strengthen their use of comprehension strategies. Their teachers require that they read regularly because reading often is the only way to become a better reader.

In order to maintain the level of reading achieved during the school year, daily reading must continue during the summer. Your child should read every day during the summer months when school is not in session!

To make this a little easier for you, we will continue with our Summer Reading Challenge. Reading logs will be mailed home with Report Cards.

Details:

- If your child reads at least 6 days a week and completes the log, they will be awarded a prize. If they do this all summer, they will be awarded a trophy in September and acknowledged at a school-wide assembly.
- 2. Rising 1st graders should read 20 minutes a day (6 days a week).
- 3. Rising 2nd, 3rd and 4th graders should read 30 minutes a day (6 days a week).
- 4. Bring the log into school on most Tuesdays to collect a prize, or hand in the log in September. (The log has all the dates listed to claim a prize.)

Please encourage your child to read each day.
