
Roaring Back to School!

A note from Dr. Sepe.....

The year is almost ready to kick-off! We thought we would be past the COVID crisis by now, but it will not stop us from bringing everyone back together in

September! We are anxious to re-establish our normal school year routines and see your children face-face each day!

The first two days of school are before Labor Day and will help to ease 9th and 10th graders into the building, some of whom have not been in school in over a year. On **Thursday, September 2nd,** 9th and 10th graders **ONLY** return to school, and on **Friday, September 3rd**, the 11th and 12th graders **ONLY** will return. As a note, due to the upcoming holidays, we will not have our first full week of school for all students until September 20th. The schedules for each day are included in this communication.

Information from our Assistant Principal, Mr. Mello

We are so excited to see so many students taking advantage of the IB programs in the high school and the positive effect the program has had on our school community. IB courses provide

students with a rich, in-depth, and challenging educational experience that focuses on the skills that will better prepare them for whatever they face in the future. Like AP exams, IB courses also have a fee of \$123. Because we require every student to take IB Language and Literature in the 11th grade, the district pays for one IB course for each student. Most IB courses are two-year courses and therefore payment is not due until November 15th of the senior year. IB science courses as well as IB Psychology are 1-year courses and will incur a \$123 cost by November 15th of the year that the student enrolls.

Most juniors taking IB courses will not have to pay for any courses until their senior year but, please realize that if your child is taking multiple IB courses, there is a significant IB payment in November of your child's senior year. There are no payment plans for IB courses but if you receive financial assistance (free and reduced lunch) the cost is significantly reduced. We are also able to work out payment plans for families that need financial assistance.

Please talk to your child or guidance counselor about the IB courses your child is taking this year and if those courses are one or two year courses in order to plan for payment.

We will be using Total Registration to accept payments starting in the beginning of September. More information will be sent out about payments for IB courses at the start of the school year.
