## Summer Intramural Camp June 28th - July 2nd

**Program Overview:** Participants will play a variety of sports, games, and activities with variations to keep the day enjoyable. Participation, socialization, learning, and fun are emphasized through group activities, challenges, and games. Participants will be grouped by grade level with a maximum of 15 campers per group, and a maximum of 100 campers.

**Time:** 9:00am-4:00pm (Lunch: 11:15-11:45)

**Rain Dates** (if necessary): Tuesday July 6th (then July 7th, 8th, 9th).

**Location:** Johnson Field, Putnam Valley Town Park (next to the Pavilion). Drop off and pick-up on Johnson field/Pavilion. Only one family member/guardian can pick up the camper, and family member/guardian needs to wear a mask.

**Grades:** Kindergarten - 8th grade (Grade Level as of 2020-2021 school year). C.I.T. positions available to High School students (9th-11th grade).

**Cost:** \$200.00 per camper

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## Important Covid Information:

Campers will be wearing masks, follow social distancing guidelines and encouraged to wash their hands throughout the day, and the equipment shall be washed between groups. Campers will be in separate groups for the entire day.

## Bad Weather/Property Info:

Due to covid, this is not a normal year for our camp, and since we are not able to use the Middle School Gym (this year), we have different guidelines to follow. If there is bad weather forecasted (all day) camp will be cancelled. For all changes to the camp day, we will update parents either the day before or that morning (as early as possible). If storms occur during camp, and lightning is present, an email will be sent and a parent/guardian will need to pick up the camper as soon as possible. If camp were to be cancelled or closed for more than ½ a day, the Intramural camp will have a make-up day the following week. The Pavilion will be used for lunch (campers will be spread out in order to eat without a mask), as well as all weather related events. There are bathrooms in the Pavilion which will be easily accessed throughout the day. All supervisors will take campers for bathroom breaks in order to keep the group together at all times.

## Clothing:

Please provide all clothing (including a mask) necessary to be outside each day, as well as sneakers, water, and a bagged lunch. All bagged lunches will be stored in a refrigerator.

## Summer Intramural Camp Program Refund Policy

A credit or refund will be given for any program cancelled by the Putnam Valley Parks and Recreation Department. Once a participant has been enrolled in a particular program, refunds will not be considered, as these programs are dependent upon structure and pre-arrangement. Therefore, anyone signing up pays a non-refundable fee. Refunds would only be granted if the participant were to miss a prolonged period of time (more than half the program) due to injury/illness and is no longer able to participate for the remainder of the program. When the participant becomes ill/injured, a doctor's statement must be presented for verification. All refunds given will be prorated from the date of notification to the Recreation Department.

**Note:** All fees are 100% refundable if requested ten days prior to program start dates. Requested refund checks take at least two to four weeks to process. The Town of Putnam Valley will charge a \$20 service for returned checks. Inquiries regarding refunds should be directed to: Putnam Valley Parks and Recreation Department.
